

FOR NIKON 90i AND Ti USERS – GENERAL RULES

- 1) Booking is required for the use of microscopes. Use the website <http://aulegest.uniroma1.it/aulegest1/fac14/home.php> to check availability and contact Giulia Guarguaglini (giulia.guarguaglini@uniroma1.it). Cancel your booking if you do not use your slot, so that microscopes are free for other users.
- 2) The first time you use the microscopes you will need a short training by Giulia, or, if she is absent, Lia Asteriti.
- 3) Detailed informations about:
 - a) how to use the 90i microscope;
 - b) image acquisition;
 - c) image analysis (qualitative and quantitative);
 - d) how to use the Ti microscope (includes video acquisition, editing and assembling)

are available (in printed form close to the microscope of interest, and as files on the Desktops of the microscope-associated computers)

Users must be aware of informations contained in the basic files (a-d). Complete instruction manuals for 90i, Ti, NIS Elements and OKOLAB are also available close to the microscopes.

- 4) All instruments and computers (except from the Lauda waterbath) are connected to UPS - uninterruptible power supplies- that must be always ON.
- 5) Computers:
 - Indicated as 90i, in vivo, micro-workstation. They are all connected for transfer of data and for internet connection (please limit the Internet use on these computers to avoid virus infections)
 - Save your data in the following directories: “C/Users/Cartella personale”; per utenti esterni: “C/Users/Utenti esterni/Cartella gruppo/Cartella personale”
 - Periodically check your folder and transfer/cancel data.
